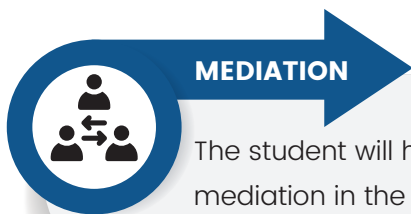


The Summer Study Abroad Program offers students reference tools, and practices for conflict resolution through an innovative teaching experience focused on developing the soft and hard skills needed today.

Main Program & Workshops

This program is suitable for participants interested in developing skills in negotiation and mediation and who have the ambition to integrate an international network of professionals who lead the development of alternative dispute resolution and online dispute resolution on a global scale.

It also integrate different workshops with specific themes - negotiation, family, insolvency, commercial mediation - that will allow participants to have an experience of interactive learning, building relationships and problem-solving skills.

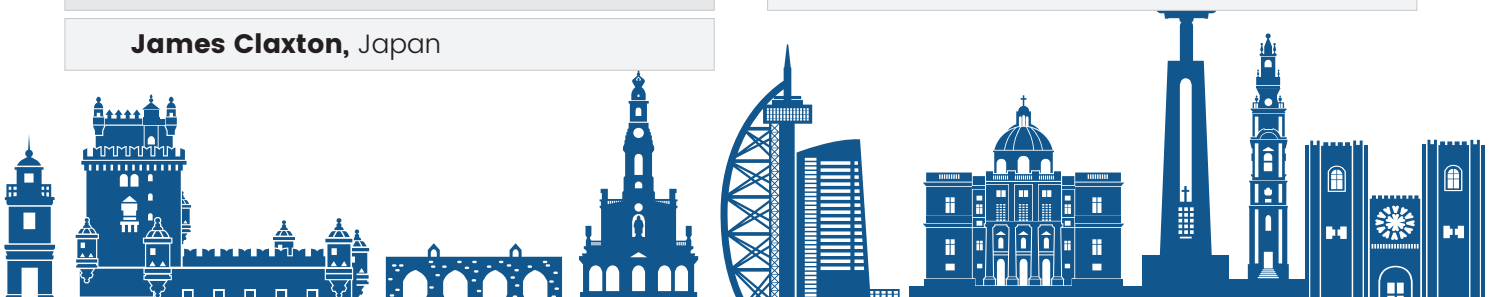

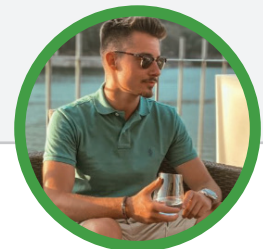
